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Additional Permits and Information

- A building permit may be required for the concrete pad to install/mount the tank onto if it is an aboveground tank.
- An electrical permit may be required if a pump or lights is needed at the tank.

Application for these permits are done through the County Accela program.

- Permit Fee of \$293 for each tank is due upon submission of application and is non-refundable if the application is denied. Corrected applications re-submitted for approval will be no additional fee.
- A site inspection to ensure compliance with the North Carolina Fire Prevention Code and NFPA requirements will be required prior to filling or removal of any tanks.
- It shall be the General Contractor's Responsibility to contact the Fire Marshal for an inspection at the appropriate time.
- It shall be the contractor's responsibility to ensure all work is compliant with NC Fire Prevention Code, NFPA standards and all local laws.
- Any variation from the conditions or information submitted will void this application and require a new application to be submitted unless approved by County Fire Services Office.
